Portland Rose Festival Open House

The Rose Building was originally built to be Portland's Visitors Information Center, designed by famed local architect John Yeon, whose work is known for its reflection of Northwest modernism. Open in 1949, the building has also been used as a museum, a meeting place and a restaurant. After standing empty for nearly three years, the newly-renovated Rose Building became the headquarters of the Rose Festival on March 19, 2010. The Open House on May 21 will feature a vocal serenade, wine tasting, and tours of the new rose garden, planted in 2009.

Historic Belmont Firehouse

With a significant presence in Rose Festival parades for decades, the Portland Fire Bureau currently has 30 fire stations throughout Portland, with 40-50 former fire stations lining Portland's borders. The Historic Belmont Firehouse was built in 1912 and was transformed in 2003 into the Safety Learning Center & Fire Museum. The many interactive exhibits include the "Fire Engine Experience" simulator, a real fire pole, and many other interesting and educational exhibits.
