This is the first of two days featuring local musical talents. Tonight's lineup showcases the best of Portland's ska/funk music scene.



### **Oregon Music Hall of Fame Scholarship Award Presentation - 3:30 p.m.**

Originating in the early 1990's, the Oregon Music Hall of fame has inducted some 50 different musicians, jockeys and producers from around the state. Some of the 2010 inductees include: Black & Blue, Kevin Burke, and Rebecca Kilgore.



### **Keegan Smith & the Fam - 4:45 p.m.**

In 2010 Smith won Male Artist of the Year for the second year in a row at the Portland Music Awards after his band took home the award for Best Live Performance in 2009. The band was showcased at the 9th annual 2010 Florida Music Festival in Orlando and received rave reviews from attending industry reps and festival organizers. In their more recent work, the group has been working on writing the full soundtrack to the documentary, *Green Light: the Sustainable Oroville Project*, which is set to release in 2012.

### **Dr. Theopolis - 6:15 p.m.**

Oregonians have described this nine person band as "somewhere between the wacky funk of Parliament, the old school soul of the Ohio Players and modern rap". This eight-piece band, fronted by one of Portland's true musical icons, Ezra Holbrook, has earned a loyal Northwest following with its high energy live performances.



### **Crazy 8s - 7:45pm**

The legendary Crazy 8s have long been favored sons in Portland rock history. They've shared the stage with The Clash, The Neville Brothers, The Red Hot Chili Peppers, Oingo Boingo, The Violent Femmes, UB40, The English Beat and Steel Pulse, to name but a few. Their live shows continue to be a frenetic, hectic mix of ska-punk-rock-reggae-funk that is guaranteed to get a crowd worked up into a frenzy.



### **Cherry Poppin' Daddies - 9:30 p.m.**

Formed in Eugene, Oregon in 1989, the band displays their talented and unique musical style by mixing Latin pop, ska, and swing with rock. The group has recently returned to the states after a tour in Australia.
